
Methodology



- The survey sample size is **809 respondents**.
- The survey was conducted using **CATI** (computer-assisted telephone interviews) based on a random sampling of mobile phone numbers.
- The sample is representative of the **adult population** (aged 18 years old and older) of Ukraine by sex, age, size of settlement, and region of residence. The study excluded the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, and the survey was conducted only in the territories controlled by Ukraine in Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts.
- The maximum theoretical **error does not exceed 3.4%**.
- The survey was conducted on **March 25-29**, 2020.

72% of Ukrainians are concerned about the spread of the coronavirus, and every fifth is not





HOW MUCH ARE YOU CONCERNED ABOUT THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS IN YOUR AREA? n = 809






WHICH STATEMENTS ABOUT CORONAVIRUS DO YOU AGREE WITH THE MOST? n=809






WOULD YOU LIKE TO GET TESTED FOR CORONAVIRUS? n=809








At the end of March, 3% of the population reported that they had symptoms of cold or fever at the time of the survey








Compared to the same period in 2019, Ukrainians began to receive more news from the Internet and radio, as well as from Russian television and websites


Compared to the same period in 2019, trust to television and websites has decreased, while there is an increase in social networking sites







DO YOU THINK THE CORONAVIRUS IS A REAL THREAT OR BLOWN OUT OF PROPORTION?


