Methodology: quantitative survey of Ukrainian population

Sample size National sample: 2,017 respondents; EDPs: 1002 respondents. For analysis purposes, from the national sample 248 IDPs and 1,769 general population were disaggregated based on the displacement within the country as a result of the war.
Sample design National sample: The interviews were conducted with the residents of Ukraine aged 18 years old and older. Sample design corresponds to the distribution of adult population of Ukraine by age, sex, oblast and settlement type according to the data of the State Statistics Service of Ukraine as of January 1, 2022 (excluding AR Crimea and NGCA of Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts).

EDPs: The interviews were conducted with protection seekers from Ukraine aged 18 years and older in Poland, Germany, Czech Republic and Italy. Sample design corresponds to the distribution of protection seekers by countries according to the data of the UNHCR.

MethodNational sample: CATI (Computer-assisted telephone interviews);EDPs: SMS-CAWI: online interviews; the links to the online questionnaire were sent by SMS to
potential respondents randomly.

Fieldwork dates April-June 2023

Margin of errorNational sample: Margin of sample error (not including design effect) does not exceed 2.2%
for national sample.
EDPs: Margin of sample error (not including design effect) does not exceed 3.1%.
